MEDICAL PG IN RUSSIA

PG / Clinical Residency / Doctorate programs are conducted in English and in Russian languages. All Programs are available in English and in Russian languages.

All students who want to join Postgraduate programs, have to go for one year or six month Preparatory course to learn Russian language. The knowledge of Russian language is compulsory to study at any Postgraduate program in Russia.

Students can study any Postgraduate Program in English or in Russian language, but the knowledge of language is compulsory to interact with the patients and to write their case history at the Clinical departments.

For Medical PG (Postgraduate Education) / Clinical Residency:

Duration: 2 years (1 year or six month Preparatory Program in Russian Language + 2 Years PG / Clinical

Residency: Total 2.5 or 3 Years)

Starting Date: Can start any time of year.

For Medical PG - Surgery

Duration: 3 years (1 year or six month Preparatory Program in Russian Language + 3 Years PG Surgery = Total

3.5 or 4 Years)

Starting Date: Can start any time of year.

After getting PG degree from Russia students will be able to come back to India, for practising their medical career as a Doctor at various hospitals or medical colleges or personalized clinic in India.

Settling in Russia: Practicing and settling down in Russia is another good option you can grab on. Since you will be a post graduate from the country and you will get accustomed to the culture and living conditions of the place during your study period, settling down there will not be a bad decision at all.

Application to practice in foreign countries other than Russia: You can apply to practice in various foreign countries other than Russia to get a taste of diversity in professional space. If any, clear the medical council examinations of respective countries you may go to these countries for practice purpose or further studies. Therefore in short, you can work and settle there.

Opening up of Personalized Clinics: After PG completion, you will come out as a skilled and well-qualified in their particular specializations like Angiosurgery, Orthodontics, Pediatrics, Cardiology, Neurology and many more. So, you can practice your medical career as a specialized Doctor in any reputed Hospitals at any part of the world or can set up your own clinic, simultaneously.

Further Studies: The Post graduates, who have completed their PG in Russia, and want to proceed into research field rather than doing a job, then they have a next option i.e. to have a Doctorate Degree or PhD.Duration of these courses are generally 2-3 years and students with MBBS from Russia or anywhere, can directly apply for a Doctorate entrance exam. Entry to courses at PhD level is always through an entrance examination. On completion of Ph.D.; student has to present the thesis to the commission from Ministry of Health of Russian Federation.
